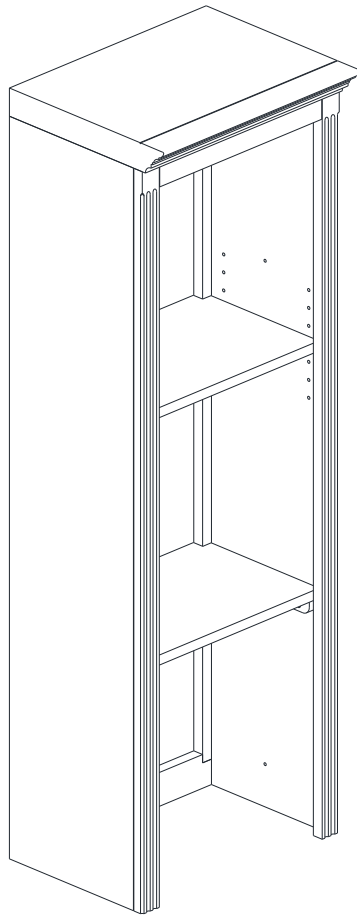

- Use only vendor supplied hardware to assemble. Using unauthorized hardware could jeopardize the structural integrity of the item.
- The Livingston Single Bookcase Hutch is designed for use with Livingston Single Drawer Pedestal or Single Glass Door.

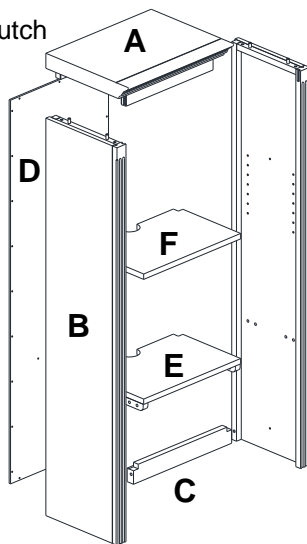
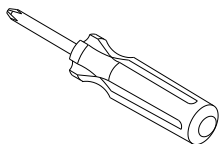
Pre-assembly:

- Remove all parts and hardware from the box and lay out on a clear carpeted or scratch-free work surface, as this will avoid damaging parts during assembly. The shipping box provides an ideal work surface.
- Do not dispose of any packaging or contents of the shipping carton until assembly is completed to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Use the parts and hardware lists below to identify and separate each of the pieces included.
- The illustrations provided allow for easier assembly when used in conjunction with the assembly instructions.
- The use of power tools to aid in assembly is not recommended. Power tools can damage hardware and split wood.

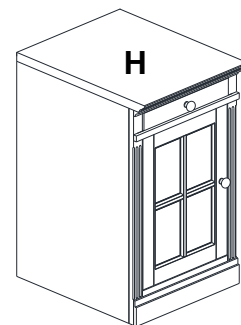
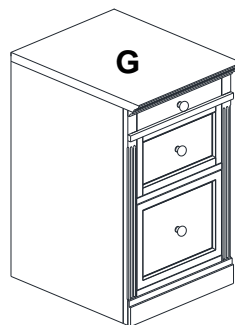

(D) Back Panel – 1x
(E) Fixed Shelf – 1x
(F) Adjustable Shelf – 1x

Hardware Enclosed:

I. Allen Bolts 1/4" x 1 1/4" – 8x	J. Allen Bolts 1/4" x 2" – 6x	K. Halfmoon Washers – 6x	L. Spring Washers – 6x
M. Bolts Connector – 3 Set	N. Allen Key M4 – 1x	O. Mending Plate – 2x	P. Bolt JF 5/32" x 1/2" – 4x
Q. Shelf Pins – 4x	R. Screw 6 x 3/4" – 24x	S. Drill – 1x	

1. Carefully lay the one Side Panel (B) on a flat, scratch-free or carpeted surface. Attach the Fixed Shelf (E) by inserting dowels on the fixed shelf into the holes on the Side Panel (B) shown in **fig. 1**.
2. Insert the Allen Bolts (I) through the holes on the cleat of the Fixed Shelf (E) into the inserts on the Side Panel (B), tighten with the Allen Key (N) as shown in **fig. 1, illustration. 1**.
3. Attach the Bottom Rail (C) to the Side Panel (B). Place Spring Washers (L), halfmoon washers (K) onto the Allen Bolts (J) through the holes on the cutout of the Bottom Rail (C) into the inserts on the Side Panel (B) as shown in **fig. 2 illustration. 2**.

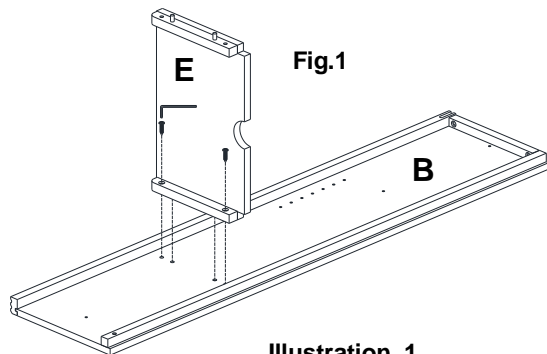

4. Attach the other Side Panel (B) and repeat step 2 & 3 as shown in **fig. 3**.
5. Attach the Top Panel (A) by inserting dowels on the Side Panels (B) into the holes on the Top Panel (A). Insert the Allen Bolts (I) through the holes on the cleat of the Side Panels (B) into the inserts on the Top Panel (A), tighten with the Allen Key (N) as shown in **fig. 4, illustration. 3**.
6. Place Spring Washers (L), Halfmoon Washers (K) onto the Allen Bolts (J) through the holes on the cutout of the front and back rails of the Top Panel (A) into the inserts on the Side Panels (B) as shown in **fig. 4 illustration. 4**.

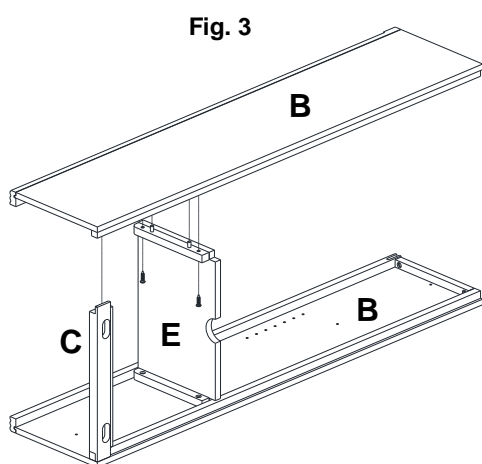

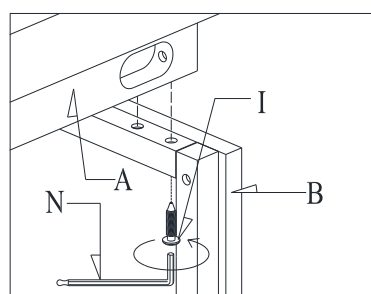

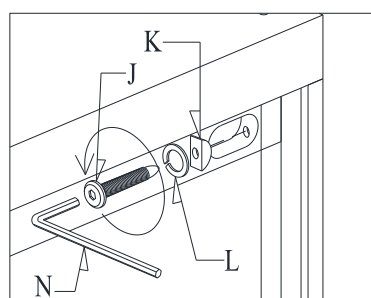

7. Attach the Back Panel (D) to the cabinet, insert Screws (R) into the pre-drilled holes on the back panel. Tighten with a Screwdriver (not included) as shown in **fig. 5, illustration. 5**.
8. Attaching Adjustable Shelves as shown in **fig. 6, illustration. 6 & 7**:
 - Determine desired height for Shelf (F), insert the Shelf Pins (Q) in the pre-drilled holes located on the side panels of the cabinet until they are fully secure.
 - Put the Shelf (F) into the cabinet by inserting the shelf “diagonally”. Place adjustable Shelf (F) onto the Shelf pins (Q). Make sure the shelves are stable.

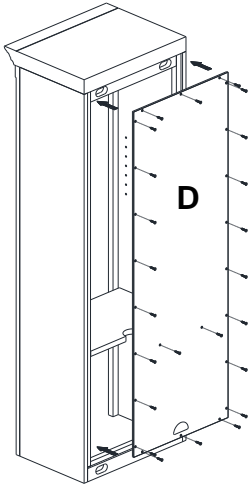

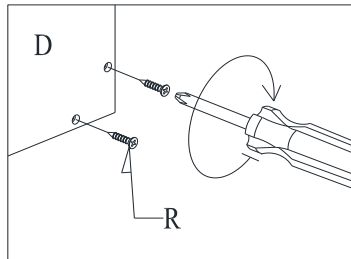

Assembly Instructions:

Livingston Single Hutch with Livingston Single Drawer Pedestal and Single Top (G) or Livingston Single Glass Door and Single Top (H) :

1. Lay Single Hutch on the Single Drawer Pedestal (G) or Single Glass Door (H) as shown in **fig. 7**.
2. Align the holes on the back of the Single Hutch with the holes on the back of the Single Drawer Pedestal (G) or Single Glass Door (H). Attach Mending Plates (O) by Inserting the flat head Bolts (P) through the holes on the Mending Plate (O) as shown in **fig. 7, illustration. 8**. Tighten with a screwdriver (not included).

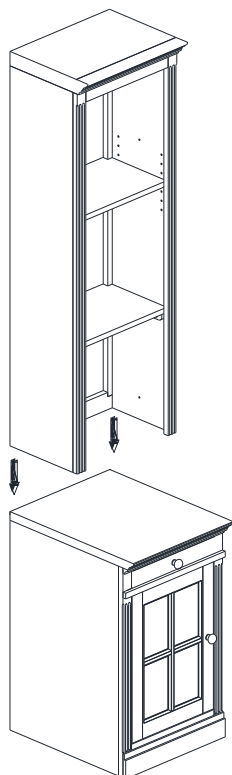
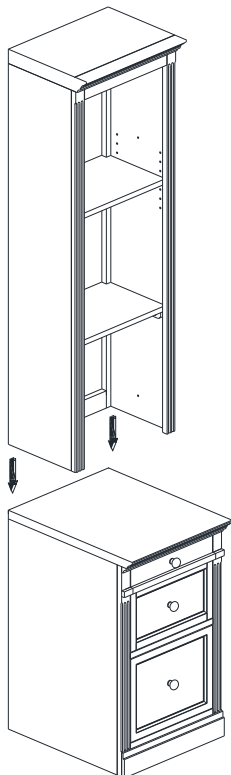

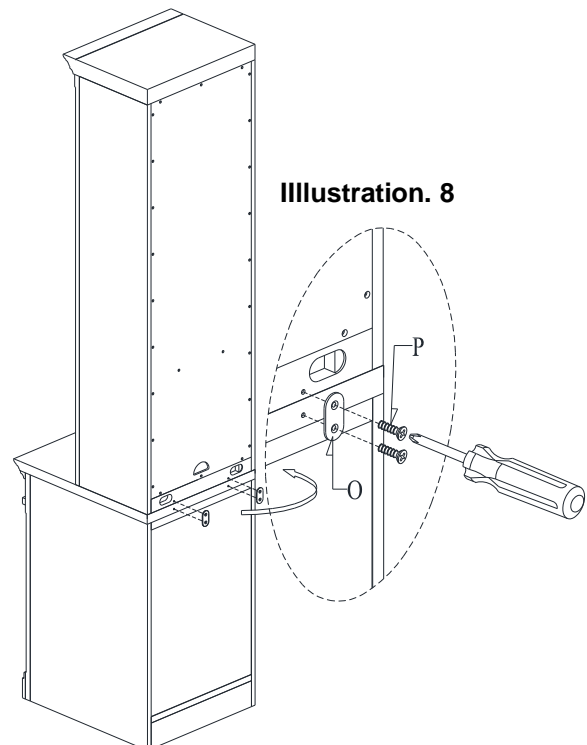

Livingston Single Hutch, Single Drawer Pedestal and Single Top with Livingston Double Hutch, Double Lateral File and Double Top.

1. Position Livingston Modular items at the desired location.
2. Use Drill Bit (S) to penetrate the pre-drilled holes on the side panels of the furniture that will be connected together as shown in **fig. 9, illustration. 9**.
3. Align the holes of each item with other and insert the connector bolts (M & M') then tighten with a screwdriver (Not Included) as shown in **fig. 10, illustration. 10**.
