Trigger Lift Cantilever umbrella Instruction Manual

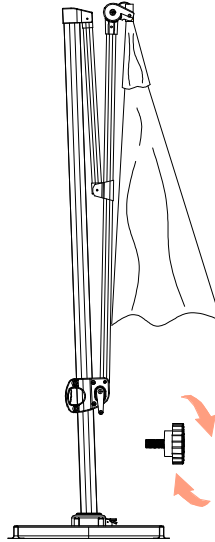

WARNING: Do not leave your umbrella in the open position during wind or rain storms. Close your umbrella when not in use. This umbrella must be used with the base designed for it.

Step 1

Secure your cantilever umbrella to the base,
See separate base instructions.

Note: For safety reasons 2 persons
are required to co-lift the umbrella to
the base.

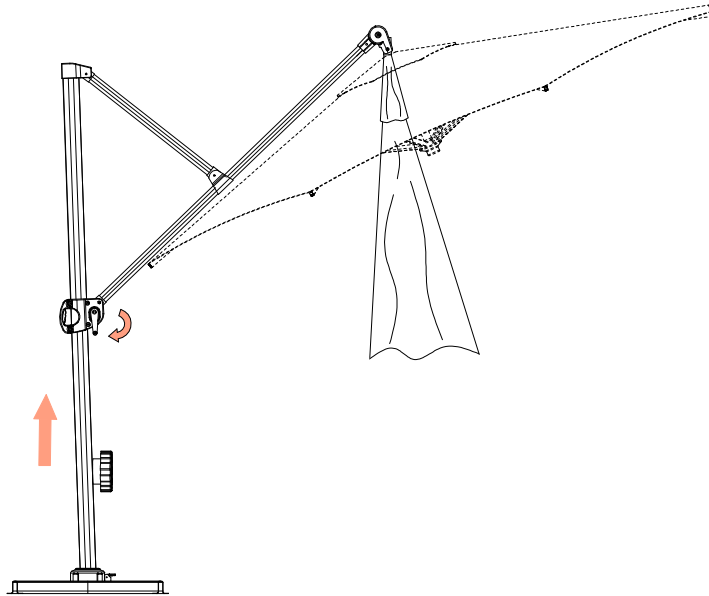


Step 2

Squeeze the Trigger and push up to
the first or second position.
Crank the handle clockwise to open
your umbrella.

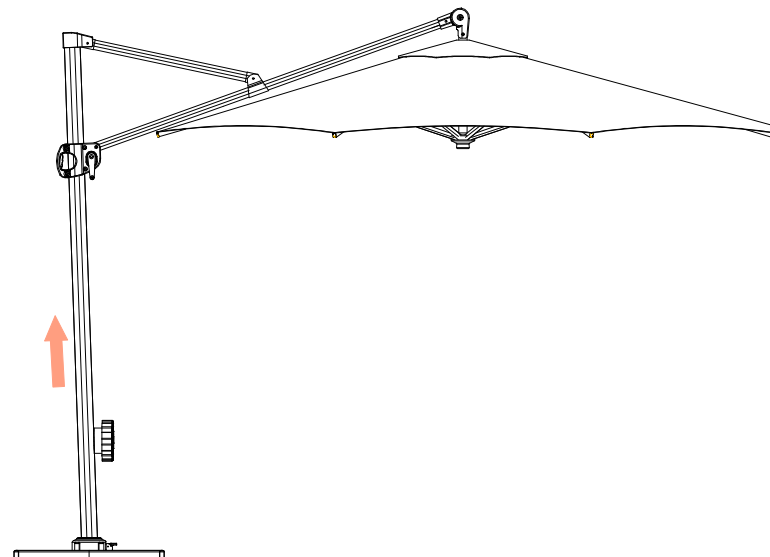
WARNING

Do not crank in counter clockwise
direction as the umbrella will go up
but not hold and suddenly will come
down.

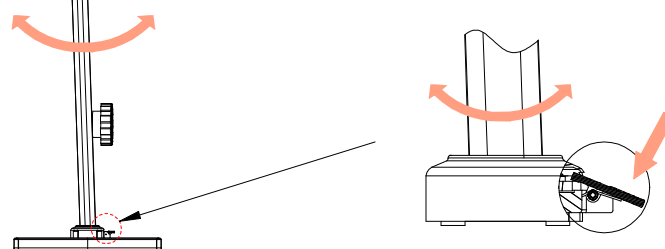


Step 3

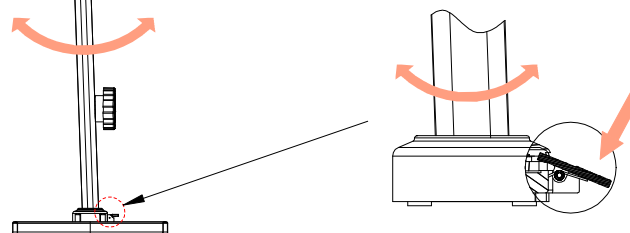
Once your umbrella has been opened
you can now squeeze the trigger and
push up to the highest position . The
fully open position will have the canopy
parallel to the ground.



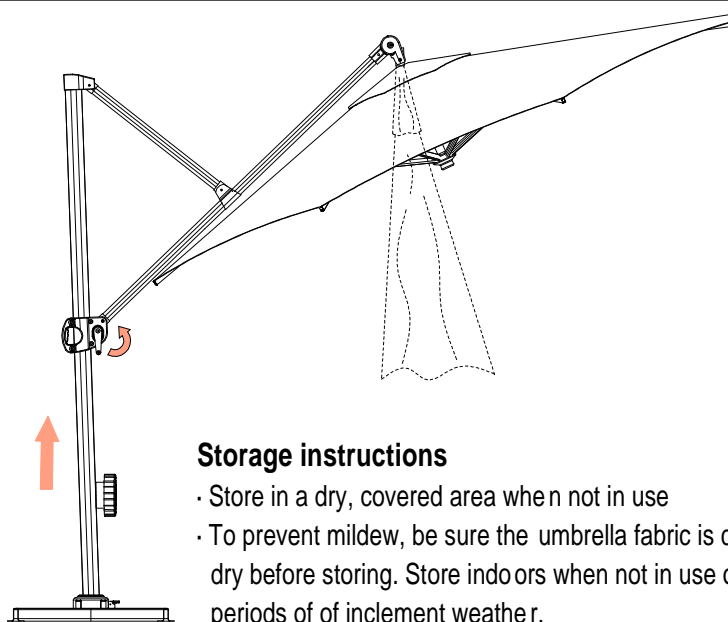
Step 4
To rotate the umbrella, you must be using an umbrella base with a 360 rotation feature. You would simply step on the pedal and rotate to the desired position.



Step 5
To tilt the umbrella you would squeeze the trigger and bring down the umbrella to one of the 3 holes for tilting.



Step 6
To close the umbrella, squeeze the Trigger again and bring down to the first or second position. Crank the umbrella counter clockwise to close. Re-Squeeze the trigger and bring all the way down.



Care Instructions

- Rush to remove dirt and dust
- For spot cleaning, sponge lightly with a solution of mild soap and warm water.

Storage instructions

- Store in a dry, covered area when not in use
- To prevent mildew, be sure the umbrella fabric is completely dry before storing. Store indoors when not in use or during periods of inclement weather.
- Cover during storage or when not in use using a proper outdoor protective cover allowing adequate ventilation without trapping moisture.
- Do not cover with plastic or similar materials that will trap moisture. Pottery Barn umbrella covers are vented and can be used.
