I. Allen Bolts ¼" x 1 ¼" – 8x	J. Allen Bolts ¼" x 2" – 6x	K. Curved Washers – 6x	L. Spring Washers – 6x


- 1. Carefully lay the one Side Panel (B) on a flat, scratch-free or carpeted surface. Attach the Fixed Shelf (E) by inserting dowels on the fixed shelf into the holes on the Side Panel (B) shown in **fig. 1**.
- 2. Insert the Allen Bolts (I) through the holes on the cleat of the Fixed Shelf (E) into the insert on the Side Panel (B), tighten with the Allen Key (N) as shown in **fig. 1**, **illustration. 1**.
- 3. Attach the Bottom Rail (C) to the Side Panel (B). Place Spring Washers (L), Curved Washers (K) onto the Allen Bolts (J) through the holes on the cutout of the Bottom Rail (C) into the insert on the Side Panel (B) as shown in **fig. 2 illustration. 2**.



- 4. Attach the other Side Panel (B) repeat step 2 & 3 as shown in fig. 3, illustration. 2 & 3.
- 5. Attach the Top Panel (A) by inserting dowels on the Side Panels (B) into the holes on the Top Panel (A). Insert the Allen Bolts (I) through the holes on the cleat of the Side Panels (B) into the inserts on the Top Panel (A), tighten with the Allen Key (N) as shown in **fig. 4**, **illustration. 3**.
- 6. Place Spring Washers (L), Curved Washers (K) onto the Allen Bolts (J) through the holes on the cutout of the wood support of the Top Panel (A) into the inserts on the Side Panels (B) as shown in **fig. 4 illustration. 4**.




- 7. Attach the Back Panel (D) to the cabinet, insert Screws (R) into the pre-drilled holes on the back panel. Tighten with a Screwdriver (not included) as shown in **fig. 5**, **illustration. 5**.
- 8. Attaching Adjustable Shelves as shown in fig. 6, illustration. 6 & 7:
 - Determine desired height for Shelf (F), insert the Shelf Pins (Q) in the pre-drilled holes located on the side panels of the cabinet until they are fully secure.
 - Put the Shelf (F) into the cabinet by inserting the shelf "diagonally". Place adjustable Shelf (F) onto the Shelf Pins (Q). Make sure the shelves are stable.


Livingston Double Hutch with Double Lateral File and Double Top (G) or Livingston Double Glass Cabinet and Double Top (H) :

- 1. Lay Double Bookcase Hutch on the Double Lateral File (G) or Double Glass Cabinet (H) as shown in fig. 7.
- 2. Align the holes on the back of the Double Hutch with the holes on the back of the Double Lateral File or Double Glass Cabinet. Attach Mending Plates (O) by Inserting the flat Head Bolts (P) through the holes on the Mending Plate (O) as shown in **fig. 7**, **illustration. 8**. Tighten with a screwdriver (not included).



Livingston Double Hutch, Double Lateral File and Double Top with Livingston Single Hutch, Single Drawer Pedestal and Single Top.

- Position Livingston Modular items at the desired location.
- Use Drill Bit (S) to penetrate the pre-drilled holes on the side panels of the furniture that will be connected together as shown in **fig. 9**, **illustration. 9**.
- Align the holes of each item with other and insert the connector bolts (M & M') then tighten with a screwdriver (Not Included) as shown in **fig. 10, illustration. 10**.








Assembly Instructions:

Livingston Double Top (A) and Livingston Double Lateral File (B)

 Open upper drawer of Livingston Double Lateral File (B). Attach the Double Top (A) on the top of the Double Lateral File (B). Insert the Allen Bolts (D) through the holes on top frame of the Lateral File (B) into the inserts on the Double Top (A). Tighten with the Allen Key (E) as shown in **fig. 1 illustration. 1**.




2. Close the drawer of Livingston Double Lateral File (B) back to the previous position as shown in fig. 2.



If the floor is uneven adjust the recessed levelers found on the bottom of the furniture as shown in illustration.

Carefully grasp one side of the furniture and elevate it slightly to provide access to levelers. Turn the leveler until adequate contact will be made with the floor. Carefully set the furniture down. Repeat until the furniture sits level and stable.





Livingston Double Top (A) and Livingston Double Glass Door Cabinet (C)

1. Release upper drawer from the cabinet by fully extend the drawer case. Locate the release tabs on the right and left-hand slides as shown on **fig. 1**. Simultaneously press the release tabs up and down while pulling out the drawer as shown in **fig. 1**, **illustration. 1**.




- 2. Insert the Allen Bolts (D) through the holes on top frame of the Double Glass Door (B) into the inserts on the Double Top (A). Tighten with the Allen Key (E) as shown in **fig. 2 illustration. 2**.
- 3. Put the drawer back to the previous positions. Slide the drawer into the cabinet. Align the drawer rails together as shown in **fig. 3**, **illustration. 3**. Avoid pushing the drawer forcefully into the cabinet, as this may damage the drawer rails. The ball bearing drawer rail should slide easily into the cabinet.



4. If the floor is uneven adjust the recessed levelers found on the bottom of the furniture as shown in illustration.4.

Carefully grasp one side of the furniture and elevate it slightly to provide access to levelers. Turn the leveler until adequate contact will be made with the floor. Carefully set the furniture down. Repeat until the furniture sits level and stable.


Configuration #1: Livingston Single Drawer Pedestal (A) or Double Lateral File (B) and Livingston Single Top (C) or Double Top (D).


To install the Livingston Drawer Pedestal (A) or Double Lateral File (B) with the Tops (C and D), please follow the assembly instruction which is come with the Livingston Single or Double Top (C and D).


Configuration #2: Livingston Single Drawer Pedestal with Single Top (C) and Livingston Double Lateral File with Double Top (D)


- 1. Open the upper drawer of the cabinet, push the fin of the Anti-Tip Interlock pre-attached on the cabinet as shown in **fig. 1**, **illustration. 1**, then open the lower drawer as shown in **fig. 2**.
- 2. Use Drill Bit (H) to penetrate the pre-drilled holes on the side panels of the cabinet for inserting Bolts Connector (G) as shown in **fig. 2, illustration 2**.
- 3. Insure all items which will be set up together have the same level. If not please adjust the levelers found on the bottom of the furniture as shown in **illustration. 3**. Carefully grasp one side of the furniture and elevate it slightly to provide access to levelers. Turn the leveler until adequate contact will be made with the floor. Carefully set the furniture down. Repeat until the furniture sits level and stable.













4. Align the holes and insert the connector bolts (G & G') then tighten with a screwdriver (Not Included) as shown in **fig. 4**, **illustration. 4**.



- 5. Attach top panel onto the cabinets (Single Drawer Pedestal/Double Lateral File) following the assembly instruction of the Livingston Single Top / Livingston Double Top as shown in **fig. 5**.
- 6. The file bars in the drawer-file have been installed for legal sized files.
- 7. If use the letter sized files, release screws pre-attached on the sides of drawer box to remove the metal holders. Position the metal holders to other pre-drilled holes provided on the sides of drawer box and insert the screws into the pre-drilled holes, tighten with screwdriver as shown in **fig. 6**, **illustration 4 & 5**.
