

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Illuminating Bath Mirror

This Illuminating Mirror has been rated for a 25-watt maximum Type C bulb. To avoid risk of fire, do not exceed recommended wattage.

This appliance is intended for household use. When using electrical appliances basic safety precautions should always be taken to reduce the risk of electric shock, burns, and other injuries, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- **WARNING: This product becomes hot to the touch. Please use caution when handling. Adjust position from the bottom of the mirror. Keep away from children.**
- For safety purposes, this appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). If it does not completely fit into your outlet, do not force it. Contact an electrician. Use this plug with an extension cord only if it can be fully inserted into the cord's socket.
- Be sure mirror is not in a position where it can reflect sunlight. Reflected sunlight can cause fire.
- Do not place or store appliance where it can be pulled into a sink, tub or shower.
- If an appliance falls into water, unplug it immediately. **DO NOT REACH INTO THE WATER.**
- To protect against electrical hazards, do not use while bathing or in the shower.
- Close supervision is necessary when appliance is used by or near invalids or disabled persons.
- Unplug appliance from outlet when not in use, before cleaning and before removing any parts. Allow appliance to cool to room temperature before cleaning or storing. Do not leave appliance unattended when it is plugged in. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Never operate this appliance with a damaged cord or if the appliance malfunctions or if has been dropped or damaged in any manner
- Use appliance only for intended use as described in these instructions
- Do not use outdoors or operate where aerosol products are used or oxygen is being administered.
- Do not drop or insert any object into any opening as this may cause an electrical hazard.
- Do not use on soft surfaces, such as a bed, where openings may be blocked.

FOR BULB REPLACEMENT:

1. Turn switch to OFF position, unplug the appliance and wait at least 10 minutes or until bulb and appliance are cooled to room temperature.
2. Loosen the screws on the mirror case.
3. Remove bulb. Replace with a new bulb. Do not use a bulb with more than 25 watts.
4. Tighten screws on mirror case to close.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

With appliance unplugged and cooled to room temperature, wipe with a soft, dry cloth. To protect the finish, do not apply household cleaners or abrasives.
