To Install

1. Kindly attach rod (C) to the base (A) with the help of threading at the end.

2. Kindly attach rod (D) to the rod (C) with the help of threading at the end.

5. Attach the back plate (E) which is fixed to base (A) to the wall, at points J & K with help of plastic anchors and back plate screws.
