Articulating Wall Sconce Assembly Instructions

Important Safety Instructions:

- For safety purposes, this lamp is equipped with a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). If the plug does not fit securely into your outlet, do not force it - contact a professional electrician. Use the plug with an extension cord only if it can be fully inserted into the cord's socket. Never alter the plug in any way.
- These instructions are provided for your safety. It is important that they are read carefully and completely before assembling fixture.
- For your safety, use only shades with an open top with a measurement of at least 3.5 inches in diameter.
- This fixture has been rated for up to (1) 60-watt maximum TYPE A standard bulb (not included). To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

WARNING: This lighting fixture contains lead, a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects and other reproductive harm. Wash hands after installing, handling, cleaning or otherwise touching this light fixture.

Parts Included:

- (1) Lamp base (A)
- (1) Adjustment key (B)
- (1) Lamp pole (C)
- (1) Threaded socket (D)
- (1) Socket ring (E)
- (1) Cord with plug (F)
- (1) Plug cover (G)

Hardware Included:

- (2) Back plate screw (H)
- (2) Metal anchor (J)

To Install You Will Need:

- Phillips screwdriver
- Flat screwdriver / Drill

Installation Instructions:

- 1. Locate a wall stud near the location where you wish to mount the fixture. If you are unable to locate a wall stud, two metal anchors (J) are included for mounting in drywall.
- 2. Measure center distance of mounting holes on back of lamp base (A), and mark two hole locations same distance on the wall, making sure both holes
- 3. If the lamp is to be mounted on a wall stud, drill two pilot holes using a 1/8" drill bit. If you are not mounting the lamp on a wall stud, drill holes to accommodate with metal anchor (J), install metal anchors (J) into both holes.
- 4. Insert both back plate screws (H) into the metal anchor (J); tighten with screwdriver. Make sure both screw heads and 1/8" long threads are left outside.
- 5. Hook lamp base (A) to the affixed screws (H) by aligning the holes on backside of lamps (A) with both screw heads.
- 6. Remove socket ring (E) from threaded socket (D).
- 7. Place lampshade (sold separately) over top of threaded socket (D), allowing threaded socket (D) to protrude through the opening of shade spider.
- 8. Attach the socket ring (E) and turn clockwise to tighten.
- 9. Insert bulb (not included) into threaded socket (D).
- 10. Remove red protective plastic (G) from electrical plug (F).
- 11. Plug into proper electrical outlet.
- 12. Installation is complete.

To adjust lamp base height:

- Loosen the adjustment key (B) by turning counter-clockwise
- Adjust lamp pole (C) to desired height.
- Secure by turning adjustment key (B) clockwise to tighten

Care Instructions:

Wipe clean using only a dry cloth. Avoid the use of all detergents and chemicals.
